Flat Rents

The SSHA is going to be raising the Flat Rent on apartments. Federal Regulations require that housing authority's offer residents the option of paying an income based rent or a Flat Rent. Flat Rents are generally between 80% and 110% of the Fair Market Rent (FMR) for a given jurisdiction. The SSHA has historically provided a Flat Rent of 80% of the FMR but due to continuing budget cuts by HUD we need to increase the Flat Rents to the current FMR. If you are currently paying a Flat Rent you will be notified of the increase and at that point, you will have the option to convert back to an income based rent in which case you would pay roughly 30% of your monthly adjusted income.

Now that spring is in the air, we want to remind everyone that it's a violation of your lease and the Law if you do not clean up after your pets and/or do not put garbage in the specified dumpster. If you fail to immediately clean up after your pet or if trash is around your unit, charges will be made to your account based on the time it takes our maintenance to clean up. The current lease prohibits "tie-outs" on lawn areas when pets(dogs) are not out.
